PARK ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-1-08-1

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE TIMES THE LIGHTS ARE TIO BE TURNED ON AND OFF, ESTABLISH THE TIMES FOR THE AVAILABLE OF THE RESTROOMS AND ESTABLISH THE AGE OF PARENTAL SUPERVISION AT THE BALLPARKS, TENNIS COURTS, BASKETBALL COURTS AND WALKING TRAIL IN THE CITY OF TAYLOR, ALABAMA.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Taylor, Alabama wishes to set out times the lights for the ball park, basketball and tennis courts and walking trail will be turned off and on, and

WHEREAS, in order to deter vandalism, the City Council of the City of Taylor, Alabama wishes to set out the hours the restrooms at the ball park will open and close, and

WHEREAS, to establish the age and under that a minor must have parental supervision upon any public playground, ballpark, tennis court, basketball court and walking trail within the City of Taylor, Alabama, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAYLOR, ALABAMA, as follows:

- Section 1. The <u>lights</u> at the ballpark, tennis courts, basketball group shall be turned off at ___8:00 p.m. __ during the winter months and ___10:00 p.m. __ during the summer months. (Winter months November March, Summer months April October) This does not apply to any group or person (s) sponsoring an event approved by the Mayor or City Council. The lights shall remain on and turned off immediately at the close of the event.
- Section 2. The <u>restrooms</u> at the ball park shall be available for use between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. during the winter months and 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. during the summer months. The time established for the locking of the bathroom doors at the ball field shall be at the close of the regular operating hours. This does not apply to any recreational or public function that is approved by the Mayor or City Council. The bathroom doors may remain open at the discretion of the group or person sponsoring the event and be locked at the close of the event.
- Section 3. The <u>lights</u> at the Taylor Walking Trail shall come on at __5:00 a.m. __ and turned off at __9:00 p.m. __ during the winter months and __5:00 a.m. and turned off at _10:00 p.m. __ during the summer months. (Winter months November March, Summer months April October) This does not apply to any public function that shall be set or approved by the Mayor or City Council.
- **Section 4.** To have the use and enjoyment of any public playground, ballpark, tennis court, basketball court, walking trail within the City, a person 14 years of age and under must be accompanied by or supervised by a parent, legal guardian, or someone at least 18 years of age and authorized by a parent or guardian to have care and custody of the minor.

Section 5. Section 4 does not apply to any recreation wherein a person 14 years of age and under has adult susponsoring the activity.
